PREPARATIONS

There are no preparatory requirements.

LEARNING VERIFICATION METHODS

For each teaching activity, a final assessment is scheduled at the end of the period in which it was carried out the course. By passing the final assessment the student obtains the credits attributed to the activity object. The final assessments may consist of written and/or oral tests (oral exam, written assignment, written or oral report on the activity carried out, test with free response or multiple choice questions, test practice or exercise using IT tools) defined by the course holder.

The final assessment, in addition to the achievement of the relevant CFU, also involves the attribution of a grade expressed in thirtieths, which contributes to determining the final degree grade.

FURTHER INFORMATION

To obtain the degree, the student must have acquired at least 120 university credits (CFU) recognized by the Department Council and must have successfully passed the discussion relating to a final test. The final exam consists in the preparation of a thesis aimed at further investigation a topic covered in the teachings carried out during the Master's Degree Course and in its discussion in a public debate. It involves the implementation of a research or analysis activity of cases and concludes with the drafting of a thesis, of an original nature, which demonstrates mastery of topics, capacity for autonomous elaboration, also drawing on concepts, theories and methods of disciplines different, and a good level of communication.
